How to Pray for Polar Blast

VBS remains one of the top evangelistic outreaches of the church, resulting in more than 75,000 professions of faith annually in the Southern Baptist Convention alone. Additionally, each year during VBS thousands of kids, teens, and adults respond to the calling of God on their lives and make public a decision to pursue a career in ministry or missions. Many of today's church leaders, pastors, missionaries, and teachers share a similar testimony. VBS is important work! And it's one MHBC must undergird with prayer.

Here are seven specific things MHBC can pray for as we get ready for our VBS:

1. Ask for the Holy Spirit to bless our efforts @ Hurley School. We are praying for 150 participants.
2. Pray for the teachers, volunteers, and workers who will serve during VBS. Ask God to receive their hours of preparation as a pleasing offering and for the Holy Spirit to be at work in and through them.
3. Pray for the children and the adults who will attend VBS. Ask God to begin preparing their hearts to respond to the Good News they will hear at VBS. Pray for their physical safety and emotional well-being during the week.
4. Pray for those who are unchurched in our community who will join MHBC for VBS. Ask God to soften your own heart and the hearts of MHBC to welcome, serve, and build relationships with everyone who enters our doors.
5. Pray for those who will share the gospel during VBS and those who will follow-up with children, students, adults, and families. Ask the Holy Spirit to give them clarity, guidance, and discernment.
6. Pray for churches around the world who will conduct a VBS, Backyard Kids Club, or other evangelistic outreach this summer. Pray for God's Kingdom to be expanded.
7. Thank God in advance for the blessings and opportunities He will provide through VBS.

Father's Day June 17 Men, How are We Doing?

God works through God-fearing men to produce God-fearing families. This results in the power of the Spirit working through the bride of Christ (local church), taking the gospel to their own community and to the ends of the earth.

Proverbs 1:7 (NASB)

The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; Fools despise wisdom and instruction.

1. Your father: Adam (Genesis 1–3)

- A. Marriage is a covenant (Prov. 2:16; Mal. 2:14).
- B. Men are the covenant head, responsible for their wife and family (Gen. 2:18; 5:2; 1 Cor. 11:2–16, 14:33–34; Eph. 5:21–33; Col. 3:18; Titus 2:3–5; 1 Pet. 3:1).
- C. Adam and Eve both sinned, both are at fault, and both are cursed, but God held Adam responsible (Gen. 3:9).
- D. Marriage is cursed (Gen. 3:16). Work is cursed (Gen. 3:17–19). Jesus is the only hope (Gen. 3:15).

Your Manhood

Like Adam, the sins of men fall into two general categories: sins of **commission** (doing what you're not supposed to do) and sins of **omission** (not doing what you're supposed to do). This leads to chauvinistic or cowardly tendencies:

Chauvinism

- A No Sissy Stuff Sam: whatever women do, do the opposite
- B Success and Status Stewart: masculinity = material success
- C Give'em Heck Hank: angry and abusive
- D I'm the Boss Bob: domineering and controlling; in authority, not under authority

Cowardice

- A Little Boy Liam: never grew up, disorganized, lives with his mother, etc.
- B Sturdy Oak Owen: absolutely dependable but emotionally absent
- C Hyper-Spiritual Henry: Hides behind religious behavior and "God talk." Talks at you but not to you.
- D Good Time Gary: irresponsible life of the party

Your Savior: Jesus Christ (the Last Adam, 1 Cor. 15:45)

Ephesians 5:25 calls men to love their wives as Christ loves the Church. Men are not ready to be good husbands until they are a part of the Church and understand how Christ loves the Church by taking responsibility for her and sacrificing himself for her. The essence of true masculinity is taking responsibility.
